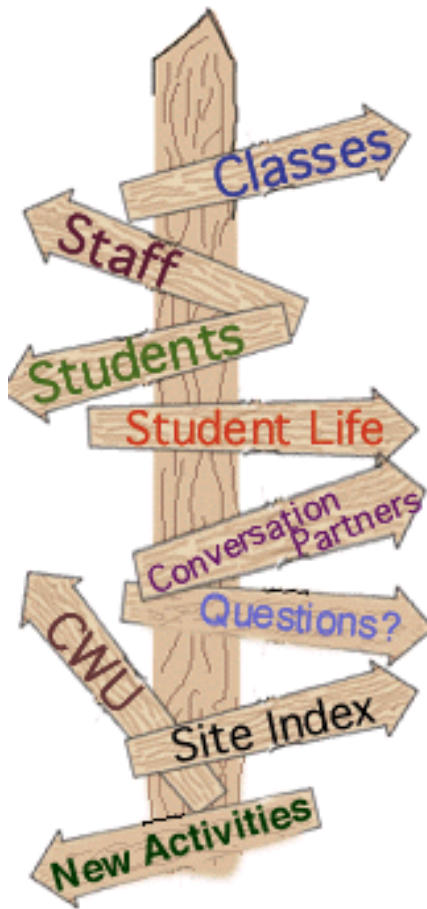

CWU offers **Conditional Admission**. If you meet all of CWU's undergraduate admission requirements except the TOEFL score, you may be conditionally admitted. In order to be fully admitted to CWU as an undergraduate, you must enroll in the UESL Program and either:

1) Complete Level 5, the highest level, (minimum of "B+" required in all classes) and receive strong recommendations

OR

2) Receive a TOEFL score of 525 on the computer-based TOEFL test

After you apply for a specific quarter, the CWU Admissions Office will give you a year in which to meet the language requirement. As soon as the language requirement is met, you will be admitted to CWU.

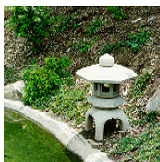

ALCOHOL-FREE (NO ALCOHOL) AGREEMENT

Central Washington University

1. I will not have or drink alcohol in the residence halls(except in Sue Lombard and North Hall for students who are 21 ears old or older). I will only legally drink outside any University-designated Alcohol-Free Hall, and I will make arrangements to stay at another location when under the influence of alcohol. I therefore will not enter an Alcohol-Free Hall when under the influence of alcohol.
2. I agree that hosting guests within my residence hall, who have drunk alcohol, violates this contract; I, therefore, will not host such guests and will ask them to immediately leave the hall.
3. I realize that a Residence Hall Arbitration Council (WAC 106-120-210), which includes two Alcohol-Free Hall residents as panel members, will meet to investigate an alleged resident or staff member in violation of this contract. In addition, I understand that the Council will make incident resolution recommendation to University officials.
4. I understand that violation of this contract will result in University disciplinary action under the Student Judicial Code (WAC 106-120) and may also result in my removal from an Alcohol- Free Residence Hall.
